Retirement Program Match

The Town of Waverly Hall will contribute one percent to all employees whether or not they choose to participate in the retirement program. The Town of Waverly Hall will contribute two percent for the employees who choose to make contributions in the program. The employee must contribute at least one percent in order to receive the two percent match from the town. Council Member Marriner made a motion for the retirement match. Council Member Boddie made the second motion. Motion passed unanimously. (Lowman)

Health Insurance Benefits for Employee & Family Coverage

A motion was made by Council Member Lowman for the Town of Waverly Hall to contribute 80% for employee health insurance coverage. The Town of Waverly Hall will only contribute 20% for Family Coverage. Council Member Boddie made the second motion. Motion passed unanimously. (Marriner).
