

MINUTES
REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
FEBRUARY 3, 2020
6:00 P.M.

COUNCILMEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Michael Harris, Mayor Pro Tem Pat Lowman, Bryant Wallace and Geraldine Boddie. Others Attending: Sandi Mathis, AFLAC.

COUNCILMEMBERS ABSENT: Jan Vardeman and Rob Miley.

Mayor Harris called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. in City Hall. Mayor Harris gave the invocation and led the pledge of allegiance.

Councilmember Boddie made a motion to approve the agenda and Councilmember Wallace made the second. A vote was taken and the results were unanimous. (3 ayes)

Councilmember Lowman made a motion to approve Ella Marshall the use of the Lowman Community Center for February 22, 2020 and Councilmember Wallace seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the results were unanimous. (3 ayes)

Department Reports

Fire & Public Safety:

Chief Spencer requested the purchase of a new police four wheel drive truck to help meet FEMA requirement. Chief Spencer advised that he could use the technology money to outfit the truck with camera, computer, etc. Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem will meet to review the budget for consideration of this purchase.

Water:

It was reported all new meters have been installed. We need the CDBG grant surveys returned by mid-February. The status of the returns is being monitored.

Mayor Update:
