New Business:

1. Marcus Hinton new trucking business: Motion to approve new business made by Councilmember Lowman, 2nd by Councilmember Miley. All approved 3 (ayes).
2. Swearing in of Gregg Fischer to finish the term of vacated council post # 3 – Streets and Roads: City Attorney Dennis McPherson administered the oath of office to newly appointed Councilmember Gregg Fischer.
3. WavCom new parent ownership is ITC Broadband Holdings LLC, West Point GA. Agreement with Wavcom expires in April 2022. City attorney McPherson presented an ordinance for a 3% franchise fee for Waverly Hall Telephone Company. Motion made by Councilmember Lowan to approve the ordinance, 2nd by Councilmember Wallace.
