Unfinished Business:

1. Harris County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2020-2025: City Attorney McPherson reviewed the Harris County Mitigation Plan 2020-2025. There are some discrepancies in the description of Waverly Hall, but overall, there was no reason for The Town of Waverly Hall to not adopt the plan. He suggested Waverly Hall have more presence at the next planning. Fire Chief Alex Lawske was present from Waverly Hall for the 2020-2025 Plan. Motion made by Councilperson Boddie to adopt the Harris County Mitigation Plan 2020-2025, 2nd by Councilperson Lowman. All approved (5 ayes)

New Business:

1. Eddie Hazzard new business license for car wash: The location proposed for the carwash does not have sufficient drains for the water runoff. Council suggested the current carwash location would be a better option. Mr. Hazzard will check into that location.

2. John Bunn, Michael Harris -representing Greenberry Farms, requesting to move driveway and get permit: Council tabled the decision to give City Attorney McPherson time to consult with Harris County.

Residents' Concerns:

1. Jessica Holt Stewart has an issue with speeders on Mt Airy Road. Children are at the bus stops while it is dark, and cars are driving more than the speed limit in a 25 MPH zone. She asked if patrol could be in that area in the mornings. The stop sign at Moore Circle and Mt Airy Rd has been removed several times. Maintenance has replaced it three times in the recently. Mrs. Stewart would like to have a streetlight added in the Moore Circle Mt Airy location.

Departments reporting:

1. **Buildings and Grounds: The storage building needs organized. Nothing more to report.**

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2. **Streets and Roads:** Pavement Repair Solutions has submitted a bid to repair several roads. A second bid will be coming from Phenix Paving and Maintenance.

3. **Parks and Rec:** Parks and Recreation are finalizing Plans for the Christmas Lights Contest. No update on the lights for the 208 ballfields.

4. **Fire and Safety:** The Police Department bought a 2020 Ford Explorer with 2019 Splost Funds. The Ford Crown Victoria sold on GovDeals.

5. **Water:** The well on Storey Drive is being drilled, by Middle Georgia Water Systems. The water tanks are staying full. American Tank will check the gauge on the wells this week.
