Department's reporting:

1. **Buildings and Grounds: Councilmember Boddie reported the painting at Perkins Park is complete, new air conditioners have been installed at the Bobbie Lowman Center and Melody Lakes Community Center bathrooms have been updated. She is getting estimates to place broken windows at the Bobbie Lowman Center and in city hall.**
